Approval of Agenda

Financial Reports

Jan Hirsch read her report and stated that we have two customers currently eligible for a liens. The property at 5902 SLSD owes \$482.80, and the property at 6142 SLSD owes \$316.88 the directors voted to file those liens.

Treasurer's Report

Frances reported the balances as January 31, 2018. O&M checking balance is \$63,754.09; Debt Service Reserve is \$66,845.77; Surplus Account is \$325,191.02; Short Lived Assets Reserve not reported this month.

Old Business

Missouri One Call No calls were reported in January.

Treatment Plant Operations

Dave's report included work at 7704 Lakemont. It had been reported as a frozen line and since the weather has warmed up the system has been functioning. A bad float was discovered during the

inspection and has since been replaced. It is believed the line between the tank and the street was frozen. The tank has since been pumped again. We will have MO One Call come and measure depth of line. That could shed some light on the issue.

The problem on Circle Drive and SLSD was a break due to a frozen line. The damage was repaired by AA Quick.

New Business

Jan presented the proposed PWSD#13 Operations Budget and Projected Cash Flow for 2018 and after a motion by Steve and a second by Lora a vote to approve was unanimous.

The election for two new board members has been cancelled. No one filed to run for the positions and Wayne and Marilyn have agreed to continue in those positions.

Wayne made a motion to adjourn it was seconded by Steve and was approved by voice vote.
